Today We Learn, Lead and Serve

Service is a pillar of our school. It was written into our original charter in the 90's, is currently required of our high school students (40 hours by graduation) and is encouraged of all our families today (Serve10). As we celebrate 20 years of excellence, now is the perfect time to bring our community together to affirm that core value. Therefore, on Friday, October 26, our school embarked on its first-ever Day of Service, where more than 2,000 students, teachers and parents served together for one great cause. Despite the relentless rain and cold temperatures, students of all grade levels combined to learn about the great needs of the people in Nicaragua and how they could help make a difference in their lives. In partnership with Servants with a Heart, students worked together to assemble rice bags, each student helping in his or her assigned way, whether scooping rice or vegetables, weighing, sealing or counting the bags or hefting huge sacks of rice and soy to keep the "assembly lines" moving. Finally, students colored and decorated the cardboard boxes used to ship the 8,600 bags of rice that were made that day to Central America. All said and done, our community's efforts resulted in 52,000 meals for impoverished people living a world away from life at Lake Norman Charter. Thanks to all who made this huge undertaking possible!

- Email notices You will receive a reminder email at the beginning and end of each ordering period if you answer YES to receive system emails. You can change or confirm your answer under UPDATE MY INFORMATION.
