This achievement is quite impressive because they are apart of only 576 students out of approximately 50,000 online round participants nationwide who qualified. MathCON is a prestigious academic competition hosted annually by Concept Schools. Participants from 43 states in the middle and upper grades from all types of schools, including home-schooled children, compete across several mathematical disciplines: algebra, geometry, measurement, data analysis, number systems and pre-calculus.

If you do not need all 10 of your complimentary tickets, please have your student check with his or her classmates to see if anyone else could use them. All tickets (both complimentary and additionally purchased) will be distributed to your graduate at the graduation rehearsal, scheduled for Friday, June 2.
