Lunch Program Benefit Information

Enriching the daily lives of every student is the primary goal of the Lake Norman Charter PTO and is one of the most important factors of fundraising. Every dollar raised by the PTO through the Lunch Program goes directly back to the school, which helps give our children every advantage available. You may not even realize that something as simple as buying a hot lunch for your child helps LNC. Over \$73,000 was raised from the Lunch Program in the 2015-2016 school year and has helped the school in many ways. The high school Student Council uses the money raised through the Lunch Program to provide funding for Hom ecoming, Pep Rallies, and to offset the cost of sending student delegations to conferences hosted by the North Carolina Association of Student Councils. The Athletic Booster Club recently donated \$40,000 received from the Lunch Program to develop practice fields for our athletic teams located on the elementary school property.

One nice benefit of the Lunch Program is that it provides the seniors with part of their Senior Breakfast and "Half-way There" luncheon. It also helps provide the Senior Gift that each graduating class leaves behind as their legacy to the school. TECHNOLOGY

The NCTIES Conference is North Carolina's premier educational technology conference offered to educators across the state and beyond. NCTIES stands for North Carolina Technology in Education Society, and its annual two day conference offers over 150 sessions, informal meet and greet opportunities and keynote speakers who are experts in their fields. This year the conference is being held in Raleigh, March 2 and 3 and LNC is sending 13 staff members, five of whom have been recognized as leaders in their fields and have been asked to present!

This is the fourth year LNC has sent educators to the conference. Prior to

Special requests from teachers and staff are funded that might fall outside the school budget. This might include a fridge for the teachers' workroom or a color printer for the art department. The PTO hosts a tailgate for new families in the fall and an end of year ice cream party for the teachers.

All of this is made possible each time you buy a lunch for your child. The benefits of the Lunch Program are many. It is able to provide your child with a hot lunch (and someone gets out of packing a lunch for the day) and the school community is able to grow through your generosity.
