2017-2018 Course Selection Cards and Student Information Forms

On March 21 students took home their course selection cards for 2017-2018. All course selection cards are due back to the school on **Wednesday**, **April 5**. To help your student make his/her elective choices, we created videos of our elective classes. The videos are available in <u>Schoology</u> (look for *Groups* at the top, choose your "Class of" and dick on albums on the left menu). A copy of the curriculum guide is available here.

- 8th grade students should return the course selection cards to their social studies teacher.
- 5th, 6th and 7th grade students should return course selection cards to their homeroom teachers.

Middle school students also brought home Student Information Forms containing information that we currently have on file. Please review the information on this form, make any necessary changes, sign the bottom of the form and have your student return it to his or her homeroom teacher no later than **Wednesday**, **April 5**. If your student is not returning to LNC, please complete the <u>Student Transfer Form</u> in the same manner and timeframe and have your child return it to his or her homeroom class.

5th-7th Grade MAP Testing

Students in 5th, 6th and 7th grades will be testing the mornings of Monday, March 27 and Tuesday, March 28. We are asking for your help in ensuring your child gets a good night's sleep, eats a healthy breakfast, and is on time for school each morning as we will begin testing by 8:15am. Please remind your child to take the test seriously and to do his/her best work.

The MAP is an online test and therefore your student's iPad is essential in order to complete the test. Please make sure that both your student's iPad and keyboard case are fully-charged and that your child brings his or her iPad to school both days. We do not have enough loaners to provide to students who forget their iPads and there will be no test make-ups.
