### Carpool Reminder

Please be reminded of our carpool procedures which are in place to keep our students and faculty safe while getting our families on and off our campus as efficiently as possible. Here is a [link](#) to the carpool processes along with maps. These carpool processes and rules apply to ALL our families and student drivers and are expected to be followed. Please review and contact your building principal if you have questions. Unfortunately, based on recent observations and reports, it is necessary to especially highlight the following four points:

1. Unless you have won the PTO raffle you MUST follow regular MS carpool. No vehicles are allowed to turn left into the MS parking lot unless you have a permit, i.e., sports, medical, etc.
2. Left hand turns onto our campus are prohibited (except for authorized school buses) in the morning between 6:45am-8:00am and in the afternoon between 2:15pm-3:00pm. This is a state law and violating it can result in a citation. More importantly, it is a safety hazard to make this left and crashes have resulted in the past by people choosing to disregard the law.
3. ONLY right turns are permitted out of the campus in the afternoon onto Old Statesville Road.
4. MS students are NOT allowed to walk to the HS in the PM to be picked-up. MS students found at PM HS carpool will be required to walk back to the MS.

Disregarding any of the above rules is a violation of our [Honor Code](#) and [LNC Stakeholder Expectations](#) and are grounds for consequences. Thank you for complying with our carpool process for the good and safety of all.

### Way To Go Jacob and Mason!

Congratulations to freshman Jacob Grinberg and 8th grader Mason McElroy on their recent exceptional mathematics achievements. Jacob qualified for the American Invitational Mathematics Examination (AIME) and for the AMC (American Mathematical Competition) 12B. He also earned a Certificate of Achievement for being a student in 10th grade or lower who scored above a 90 on the AMC 12. With this, Jacob qualified for the first round of the USA Math Olympiad team!

Mason McElroy made the high-school level AMC 10A and 12B team for our school as an 8th grader. Mason earned bronze for our school on the 10A and silver for our school on the 12B.
