8th Annual Food Drive for Angels and Sparrows

MS Builders' Club is sponsoring a food drive to support the *Angels and Sparrows Soup Kitchen Summer Lunch Program*. Thousands of brown bag lunches are prepared Monday - Friday each week of the summer and are delivered to needy children in local impoverished neighborhoods. Most of the children who qualify for a free lunch during the school year can no longer depend on that once school is out for the summer. The Angels and Sparrows Soup Kitchen fills this void.

LNC has supported their effort for the past seven years by donating items that help to fill the lunch bags and we look forward to continuing this tradition. Students are asked to bring in donations to school **May 21 through May 31**:

- ES will be collecting fruit snacks/rollups (Kindergarten), cracker/spreadable cheese packs (1st grade), and Nutella with bread sticks (2nd grade)
- MS will be collecting fruit cups (5th grade), Lance's crackers (6th grade), pudding cups (7th grade), breakfast bars (8th grade)
- HS will be collecting through dubs and will be collecting non-perishable items such as chips, cookies, lunch size Pringles, microwaveable lunch size soups, ravioli, stews, etc.

HS and MS students can drop items off at the designated "drop-off" area inside near the main office on their way to school in the morning. ES students can drop items off in designated boxes in their grade building on their way to their dassroom in the morning. Thank you for embracing our efforts to help this nonprofit charity!


