#### **Graduation Reminders for Seniors and their Families**

You will receive tickets for graduation at the end of graduation rehearsal on June 2 as long as all of the following items are returned and all financial obligations are addressed: iPad, iPad keyboard case, 2 charging cords, 1 charging block, or laptop and charging cord, parking pass, books, athletic uniforms, etc. You will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony unless all financial obligations are met.

**Dress Code for Graduation**: Please remember that graduation is a formal occasion.

#### <u>Ladies</u>

- Wear appropriate dress pants or a dress or skirt with a blouse.
- Wear dress shoes or nice sandals. Flip flops and tennis shoes will not be

permitted. Shoes should not hinder walking up/down stairs. BRING SHOES TO REHEARSAL TO PRACTICE IN THEM.

#### Gentlemen

- Wear a white collared button up shirt with a tie.
- Wear dress pants and dress shoes. Flips flops and tennis shoes will not be permitted.

The graduation ceremony is Saturday, June 3 at 9:00am at the Park Church. Parking at the church is limited. In order to increase the amount of parking available for guests, seniors will not be allowed to drive themselves to the church and park in the church parking lot. Instead:

- Parents should bring their graduates to the church by 8:00am on Saturday, June 3.
- If it is absolutely necessary for a student to drive himself or herself to graduation, the graduate should park in the Hornets Nest Elementary parking lot (6700 Beatties Ford Rd.) by 7:45am and get on the LNC bus to ride to the church.
- Students are expected to leave graduation with their parents. The bus will not return students to their vehicles at Hornets Nest Elementary after the ceremony.

Upon arriving at the church on the day of graduation, either by parents or bus, students should report directly to the gym. Parents will **not** be allowed in the gym. Doors to the church will open at 8:00am and guests who have tickets will be able to enter at that time. Remember: you must have a valid ticket to enter the ceremony. The formal announcement is not considered a ticket for admission.

Traffic on Beatties Ford Road near the church becomes very busy leading up to the ceremony so guests should allow plenty of time to arrive, park and be seated prior to the 9:00 am start. Once the graduate processional begins, no guests will be allowed to enter the sanctuary until AFTER the processional.

The church has limited handicapped seating and it must be reserved strictly for people in wheelchairs or with debilitating walking situations. Again, these seats are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis, so guests needing this seating should arrive early.


