8th/9th Grade PSAT

We will be administering the PSAT 8/9 to our 8th grade students on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. The PSAT 8/9 is a nationally-normed test designed for 8th and 9th grade students and provides our 8th graders with several benefits, including exposure/practice for the SAT that they will take as juniors and important feedback on their current areas of strengths and weaknesses. This information is highly valuable and will help guide course decisions for high school which our 8th grade students will be making in March. For those reasons, we highly recommend all our 8th graders take the test.
