Mr. Porter's hometown is Tiffin, Ohio and his alma mater is Heidelberg University. Mr. Porter's favorite school memories include participating in athletics and the time spent and bonds made with teammates and friends especially the annual week-long basketball camp every summer that also included time at the beach with all his teammates and coaches. When asked why he went into counseling he replies, "During college I majored in child and

adolescent psychology and worked with the youth programs (ages 5-18) at the local YMCA. The years spent at the YMCA and my own personal experience highlighted the lack of positive male role models in the lives of so many youths. It made me want to be that positive male role model which then led me to pursue a career working with youth. After interning at a local high school with a

counselor I realized the potential for impact this position holds." Mr. Porter chose LNC because he witnessed the sense of community here and wanted to be a part of it. In closing, Mr. Porter adds, "I would like to thank the faculty, students, and parents for welcoming me to the LNC family!"

Ms. Bish hails from Flint, Michigan and earned her B.A. at Kalamazoo College. She later went on to receive her master's degree in education from George Mason University in Virginia.
