ALL SCHOOLS - PTO Lunch Ordering Period Open NOW!

LNC is a bring your own lunch school. You can order lunch to be served at the school using the "Lunch Program" Quick Link on the LNC home page at www.lncharter.org or each school's individual webpage (www.lncharter.org, look in the upper right corner for "Select a School" and choose High School, Middle School or Elementary School).

Each LNC family will have only one "Family Account" for all students, but each school has a separate ordering system. It is important that all lunch orders are placed online at www.orgsonline.com for the school (HS, MS or ES) your child attends; the name of the school is located at the top of the page once you log into the system. Detailed instructions on how to use the system can be found here.

Please note:

- NEW to LNC you need to set up an account.
- Returning LNC families <u>use the same account login information as last year</u>.
- New to HS, MS or ES but not LNC (i.e. moved from 8th to 9th grade, have a new 5th grader, have a new kindergartener) - <u>use the same account login from</u> <u>last year and set up your student at the respective school by "switching schools"</u>
- Email notices You will receive a reminder email at the beginning and end of each ordering period if you answer YES to receive system emails. You can change or confirm your answer under UPDATE MY INFORMATION.


Friday, September 22: HS and MS E-learning Day; ES No School for Students

Our first E-Learning day of the year is Friday, September 22. That day is a HALF-DAY for HS and MS students (7:45-11:15am high school, 8:00-11:30am middle school). HS and MS students learn from HOME and attendance is taken virtually utilizing the students' devices. Not only do E-learning days allow us to utilize our technology and expose our students to other styles of learning, they also have potential benefits in situations when learning from home would be preferable to being at school such as a long series of inclement weather where we may otherwise need to make up days. Teachers have provided students with the information they need to have a successful E-Learning day.

Because elementary students do not have 1:World technology, they do not participate in E-Learning days. Elementary school faculty will have staff development activities all day on September 22, so there is no school for elementary school students. The other scheduled E-Learning days (November 21 and February 16) will be half-days for our elementary students.

Mid-quarter Progress

We are already at the halfway point of the first quarter of 2017-2018! HS and MS parents, please check your student's academic progress in Schoology. If you are new to LNC you may not know that we rely on Schoology for the mid-quarter progress check instead of printing paper progress reports. If you need help with setting up a parent account in Schoology, please contact Mrs. Lord for HS at jlord@Incharter.org or Mrs. Danckaert for MS at sdanckaert@Incharter.org. Since our K-2nd grade students are not yet receiving grades, parents will receive a paper report to help gauge student progress. Those reports will be sent home with your child on Monday, September 18.

Seeking Parent Opinions on School Strategic Direction

We are hosting focus group discussions at two times and locations on Thursday, September 21. Focus groups will be held at 10:00am at the elementary school (report to the Admin Building) and at 12:00pm at the middle school (report to the office). At this session, our planning consultant will ask questions and encourage parent dialog to delve deeper into school themes and trends as we continue to devise our school's long-term, strategic plan and areas of concentrated focus.

Emergency Evacuation Procedures

This week your student is bringing home a copy of McGuire Nuclear Station's 2017-2018 Emergency Preparedness Guide for Schools. If there were an emergency situation involving McGuire Nuclear Station, Lake Norman Charter would be contacted by county emergency management officials. Not all emergencies would require LNC to evacuate. Listen to local radio or TV stations to find out if our zone, ZONE 7, is being evacuated.

In the event that an emergency requires us to evacuate our campus, LNC will call parents using an automated communications system. To evacuate the campus, parents should follow these steps:

- Each carpool's designated emergency contact should utilize the current carpool
 pattern when entering the school. Make sure you post your carpool number
 prominently in your window. In the event of an emergency you can anticipate
 traffic delays in the area. The Huntersville Police Department will be directing
 traffic in and around our school. LNC staff will be positioned to assure a safe
 and expeditious evacuation. We will make every attempt to evacuate as safely,
 quickly, and orderly as possible.
- Proceed to UNC Charlotte according to the directions in the brochure. Our
 reception center at UNC Charlotte is Reception Center 7. LNC is in Zone F as
 designated by McGuire Nuclear Station. A map showing the zones is included
 in the brochure as well. You should not return home after picking up your
 student. You should report to Reception Center 7 at UNC Charlotte.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE SCHOOL AS WE WILL NEED TO KEEP OUTGOING LINES OPEN AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. We understand your need to find out about your students' safety. We will take every possible step to assure your students' safety until someone arrives.
