II. School Life Balance Update

- A. Class Rank Elimination Discussion Does GPA demotivate students from pursuing passions to stay competitive, hurts student for scholarship and/or tuition, polled numerous schools including all 16 schools NC schools and none reported that not having class rank would hurt admissions. Information needed: legislation, local school policies, graduation speaker plan
- B. Whole-Child How do we create an environment safe, engaged, challenged, supported and healthy? This could be addressed through School-Life
- C. The "what" -Social, Emotional, Social and Creative needs-operational.

III. HB514 Guiding Principal Review:

As a subcommittee, the group examined what would be needed for a potential partnership. Those would include positive financial position, maintaining core LNC philosophy/values, oversight/governance would need to remain the same. The committee also examined potential risk factors (political, financial, legal, etc.). Ultimately, the examination would be could we be a good partner to support educational options in the Huntersville area and yet ensure that current LNC programming is not at risk.
