

- Drive east on Verhoeff Drive (Huntersville Family Fitness & Aquatics on your left, CPCC on your right). Turn right on Verhoeff Extension (CPCC's 2^{nd} /east entrance). Right Turns <u>ONLY</u> permitted per Huntersville Police
- Turn left on our NEW campus drive and
- In the morning, proceed to the right lane continuing past the high school and around the track. In the afternoon, proceed to either lane (both are thru lanes to MS carpool in the afternoon) continuing past the high school and around the
- Proceed through MS carpool.
- Exit through the OLD campus drive onto Old Statesville Road

Drop-off/pick-up **middle school AND high school students** (both high school and middle school students in carpool)

- Drive east on Verhoeff Drive (Huntersville Family Fitness & Aquatics on your left, CPCC on your right). Turn right on Verhoeff Extension (CPCC's 2nd/east entrance). Right Turns <u>ONLY</u> permitted per Huntersville Police
- Turn left on our NEW campus drive and
- In the morning, proceed to the left lane and drop-off high school students.
- In the <u>afternoon</u>, proceed to **either** lane (both are thru lanes to MS carpool in the afternoon) continuing past the high school and around the track. There is no "dual pick-up" at the HS in the afternoon. Instead, HS students should walk to MS carpool via the protected Crosswalk at the field and find their vehicle by 3:10PM.
- Proceed to and through MS carpool.
- Exit through the OLD campus drive onto Old Statesville Road

Drop-off/pick-up high school students ONLY (no middle school students in carpool)

- Drive south on Old Statesville Road.
- Turn right on the OLD campus drive. Right Turns ONLY permitted per Huntersville Police.
- Proceed through HS carpool.
- Exit through the NEW campus drive onto Verhoeff Extension

Student Drivers Morning

- Drive south on Old Statesville Road.
- Turn right on the OLD campus drive (Right Turns ONLY permitted per Huntersville Police).
- Proceed to assigned student parking space.

- Proceed through HS carpool using the far left, thru lane. Exit through the NEW campus drive onto Verhoeff Extension.

Important Carpool Pointers:

- **Please** be respectful and courteous to our staff and faculty; they are doing their very best to put student safety first.
- Remain in your car and OFF your cell phone while you are in the carpool staging area or moving.
- Pull up closely to the vehicle in front of you to avoid longer-than-necessary lines.
- Once you have your student(s) do not move forward until motioned by a staff member.
- During carpool hours (7:15-8AM and 2:45-3:45PM) no one other than Staff will be permitted to turn left into the MS main parking lot (north lot).
- protected crosswalk to go to the MS. HS student drivers must obtain a walker pass for their MS student siblings. A walker pass is required for MS students to walk from the HS to the MS and can be obtained from the HS office. MS students who ride with HS drivers should remain in their vehicles until 7:30AM when they may use the

- If you are picking up both a high school and middle school student, the high school student should meet you at your car in MS carpool by 3:10 PM.

- If you are driving for MS sports you must be in the MS main parking lot (north lot), in the blue sports parking spaces by 2:45 PM.
- parking lot (north lot) to pick-up your student. On the days there is a home game on the field the carpool route around the track will be closed at 4:00PM and you will need to park in the MS main
