



Academic Growth History








75.8% of the students entering 6th Grade across the school are proficient. 48% of the students entering 6th Grade across the state are proficient.

Percentage Economically Disadvantaged














4 Year Graduation Rate

Percent graduating within four years at Lake Norman Charter




ACT Performance 6

Percent Scoring 17 or above at Lake Norman Charter





The percentage of 12th grade students who were awarded at least a Silver Level Career Readiness Certificate or scoring 17 or above at Lake Norman Charter














Percentage of students participating in state mandated standardized testing.




Students with Disabilities Alternate Test Participation






Students Per Device


Book Titles Per Student







Per Pupil Source of Funding


