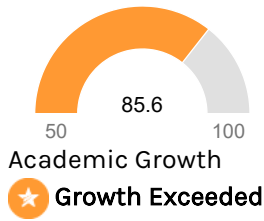

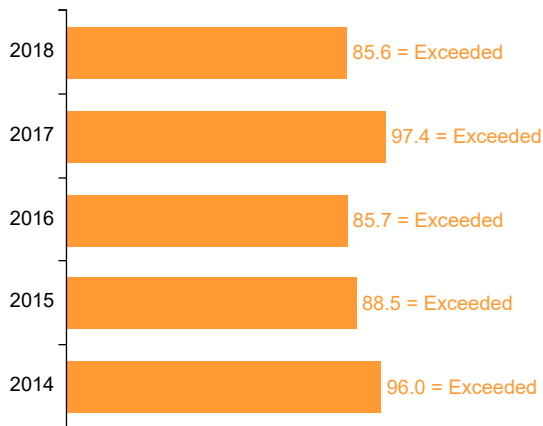

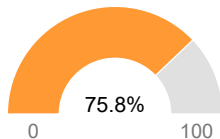

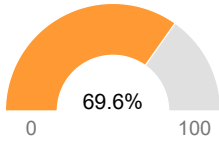

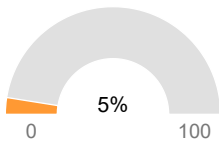

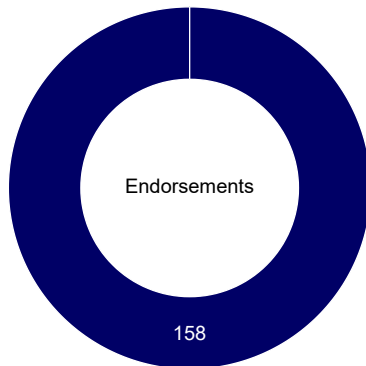

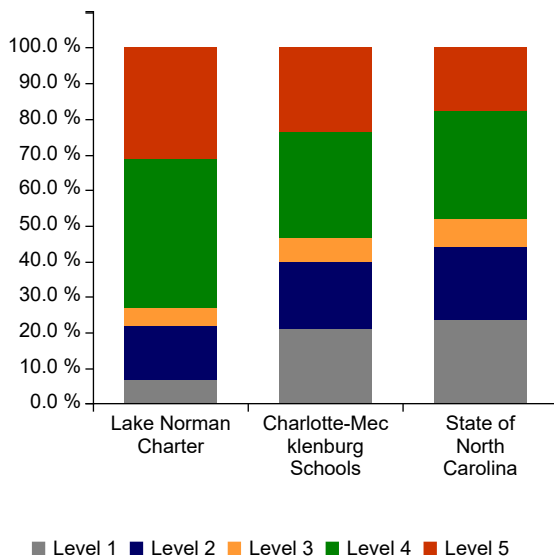

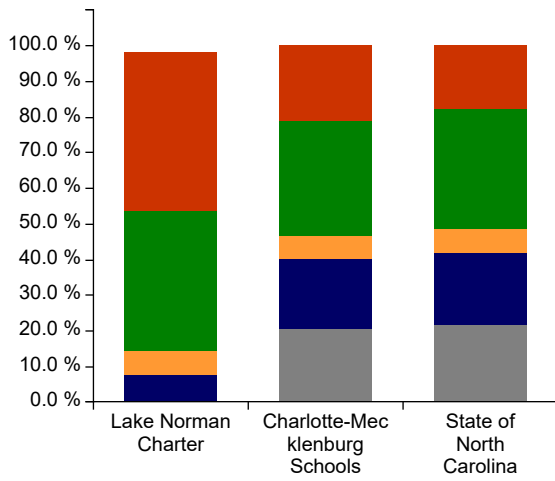

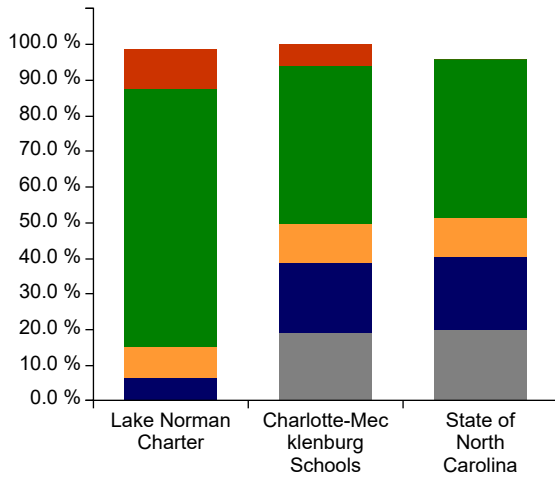

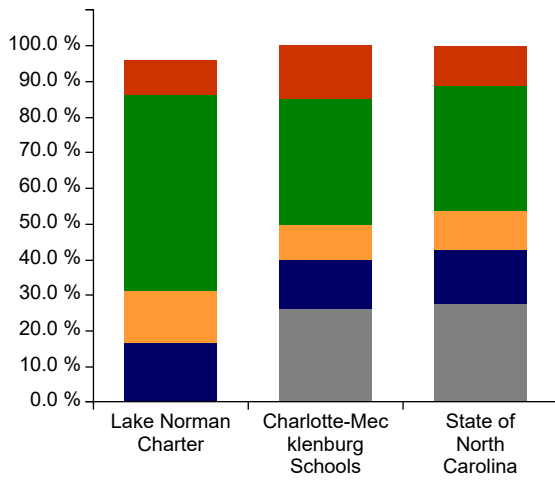
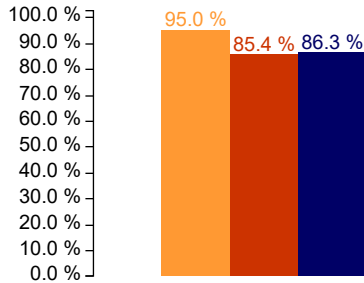

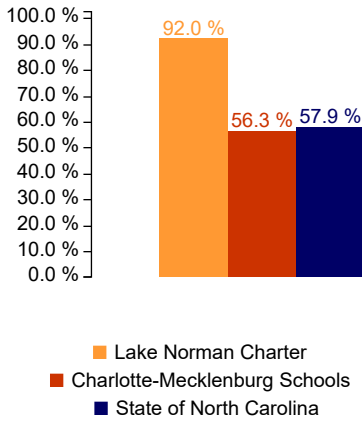
Percent graduating within four years at Lake Norman Charter

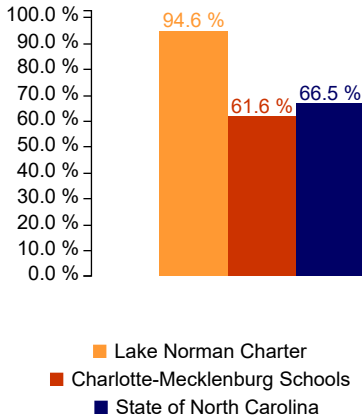

Percent Scoring 17 or above at Lake Norman Charter



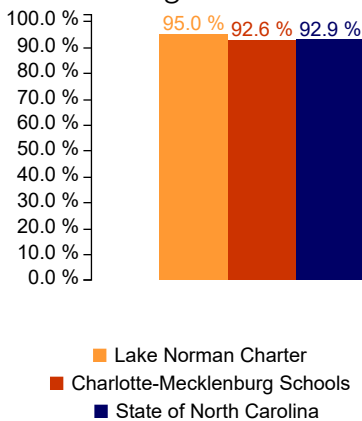

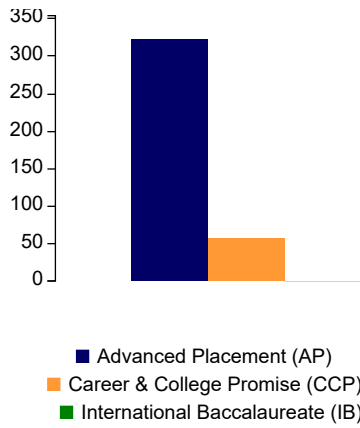

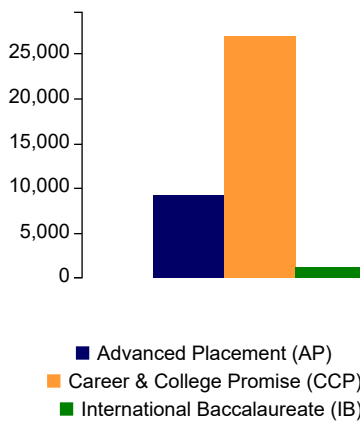

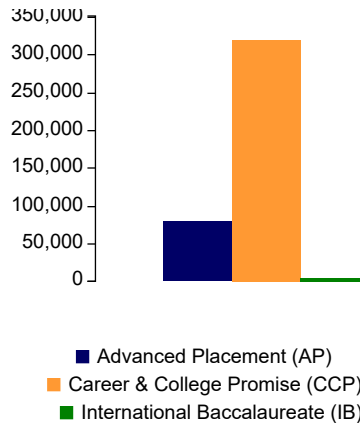

Percentage of students participating in state mandated standardized testing.

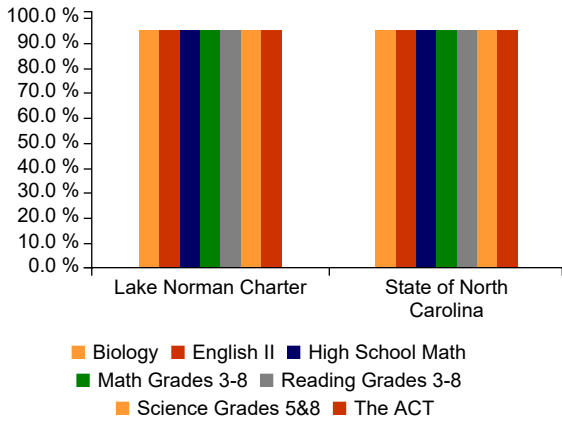

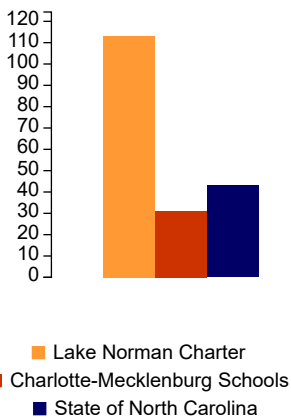

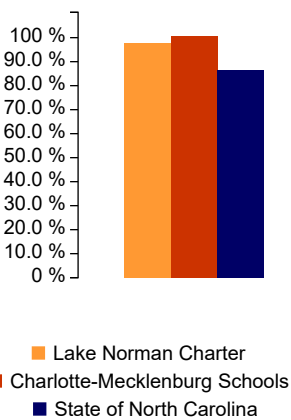

Student Attendance i



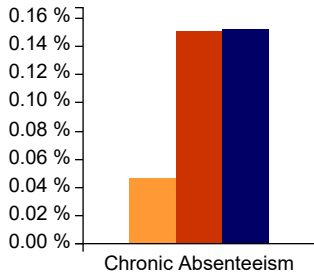
Suspension and Expulsion Rates (per 1000 students) i

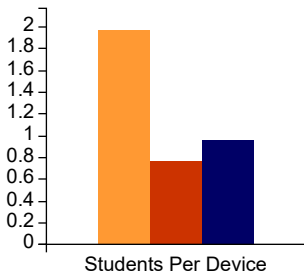

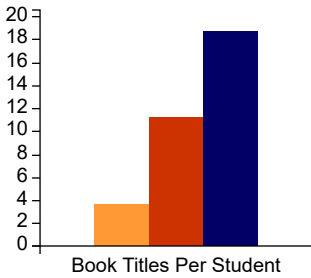
Students Per Device i

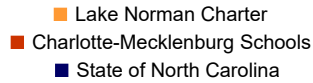
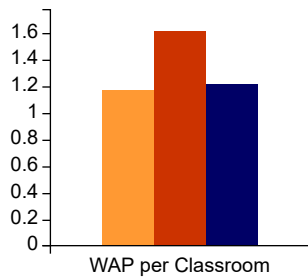
Book Titles Per Student i

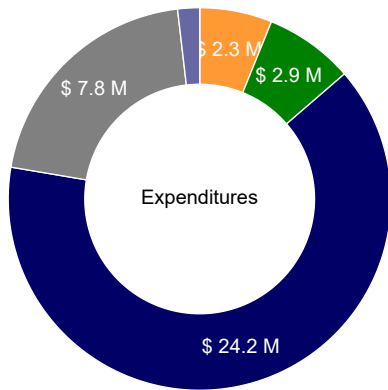
