

PTO efforts have created over \$115,000 in initiatives so far this year to support teachers, students, and our overall LNC community. Ever wonder where our money has been allocated so far?



- ★ \$37,000 for instructional staff members to receive a \$250 allotment each

LUNCH PROGRAM: Proceeds from the PTO Lunch Program are responsible for approximately 80% of our available resources each year.
