Kindergarten through 4th grade students are assigned a club from one of their three choices after participating in a club interest selection during the school day. Club Day at the elementary school is intended to promote leadership, friendships, and new experiences for our students. We are excited to provide this experience for our students once a month during September, October, November, February, April, and May.

Grades K-2
